Open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year with no nighttime noise restrictions, serving FedEx, UPS, and many international airfreight carriers such as Cathay Pacific Cargo, Cargolux and Emirates SkyCargo. The airport is part of a broader logistics cluster in Columbus, Ohio bringing air, ocean and overland capabilities together all in one geographically advantageous area. The Rickenbacker Area serves the largest companies in the world with over 100 million square feet of warehousing and distribution space clustered around the airport and adjacent rail yard.</p> <p>The site tour will include a briefing by airport executives followed by a tour of the facility, warehouses and distribution spaces allowing NITL participants an “on the ground perspective” of the areas logistics operations.</p> <p>Space is limited, be sure and register early.</p>
